The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

John 16:12-15

Whatever the Father has is mine. The Spirit of truth will guide us.

From Monday after Pentecost we return to the liturgical season of Ordinary Time. This Sunday and next Sunday, however, are designated as solemnities, special days that call our attention to central mysteries of our faith. Today, on the first Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This feast invites us to consider what we believe about God, who has revealed himself to us in the Trinity.



The verses of today's Gospel come near the end of Jesus' long discourse at the Last Supper. In this section he focuses on the shape of the future, which will include Jesus' victory over the world that they will share in. The disciples of Jesus cannot know the future. Reading this passage on Trinity Sunday reinforces our understanding of the unity shared by the members of the Trinity. Although the idea of one God in three persons remains a mystery, we have the assurance that, as Jesus and the Father share all, Jesus and the Spirit share all.

Retreat for Catholic Parents of Lesbian Daughters and Gay Sons Saturday, June 4, 2016

In June 2011, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops published a pastoral document entitled *Pastoral Ministry to Young People With Same-Sex Attraction*. It states:

Catholic parents testify that a welcoming, respectful and sensitive attitude by their parish community is especially important when they are dealing with a child's disclosure of same-sex attraction. Offer your patient assistance to parents who are grappling with the challenges of supporting a son or daughter who is coming to terms with same sex attraction and may experience isolation or repressing silence. Ostracism or the fear of being rejected, or even hated, frequently contributes to the despair that all too often is felt by these young persons. We urge you to be attentive to their parents, reducing their isolation and worry by your counsel.
