Giving hope to those in our families...


Where there is no guidance, a nation falls; but in an abundance of counsellors there is safety. (Proverbs 11:14)

Last year nearly 20,000 people received effective outreach and counselling services from ShareLife-supported Catholic Family Services agencies from across the archdiocese. Our Family Service agencies have created walk-in clinics to help clients access service faster, reduce stress about a host of issues, and improve their sense of well-being. Clients report these sessions provide practical coping skills to help them deal with issues, and they feel more hopeful about their situation.

Rob attended a walk in clinic at Catholic Family Services in Simcoe, and received immediate attention. He received additional follow-up counselling and compassionate care, which helped him to deal with his depression from previous life issues.
