In the Archdiocese of Toronto, we are fortunate to have priests in most of our parishes, in some cases supported by an associate pastor and/or Deacon. Retired clergy often help out by celebrating Mass when there is a need for assistance. In many parts of the world, there is not always a priest available to say Mass each weekend. In some Dioceses in India or Africa, parishes have many mission churches that they visit on a regular basis, but not necessarily every week.

Matthew Gunnarson, a second year student at St. Augustine's Seminary, notes 'This year and last I had the privilege of speaking at parishes during the Sunday Masses about ShareLife.
