In December, the St. Vincent De Paul Society of our parish will be accepting your donations to support our neighbours who are in need. More information will be available in the coming weeks.

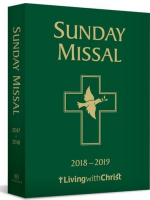
