

## St. Joseph, Husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary



Joseph, according to gospel accounts, was a carpenter and a descendant of King David. Embarrassed by Mary's pregnancy, Joseph was told in a dream to take Mary as his wife. Thoughts of rejecting her for infidelity banished, he was faithful to his responsibility as her husband and foster father of Jesus.

St. Joseph was declared a patron of the universal Church in 1870, and is principal patron of Canada.
