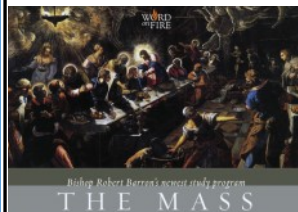

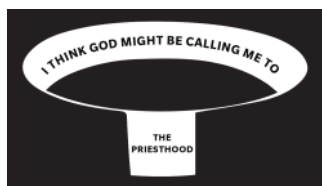
LIVING THE GOSPEL

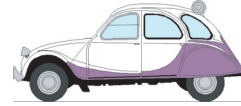
