RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION

RCIA is for adults who are not baptized, and also for those who have been baptized in other Christian Churches, but need a period of catechesis.

RCIA will begin in mid-September until after Easter. Kindly contact the Parish Office at 905-839-9774 for further information or to register.




