Last week, Hurricane Dorian devastated the Caribbean nation of Bahamas, and caused significant damage in Nova Scotia and Atlantic coast of the United States.



The hurricane moved exorciating across the Bahamian island of Abaco most buildings and infrastructure. More than 70,000 people in the Bahamas are expected to need emergency aid including food, shelter, electricity and drinking water. A still unknown number of people are missing and at least 50 people are expected to die over the coming weeks as more people are recovered. 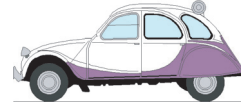
