Parents, the first teachers, who solemnly promise to raise their child in the faith, should be registered members of the Parish and should attend a preparation program on effective ways to raise their child in the faith.

**The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults** is a program of preparation and instruction designed to initiate those who desire to become members of the Catholic Church.
