Latest Covid-19 Updates

On Monday, January 3rd 2022, the provincial government announced that Ontario will be moving to a modified Step 2 of the Roadmap to Reopening. These changes will take effect as of Wednesday, January 5, 2022, with most restrictions lasting a minimum of 21 days.

Capacity restrictions for places of worship are set at 50% of pre-Covid capacity however distancing of 2 metres (6 feet) must be maintained by those not from the same family. The following guidance has been given:

- In light of the highly contagious Omicron variant, the archdiocese strongly recommends against congregational singing at this time
- Those feeling unwell should not attend Mass at this time. We also remind those attending services that parishioners not congregate in large groups before or after Mass, wherever possible.
