Parents, the first teachers, who solemnly promise to raise their child in the faith, should be registered members of the Parish and should attend a preparation program on effective ways to raise their child in the faith.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a program of preparation and instruction designed to initiate those who desire to become members of the Catholic Church. THE MONTH OF MAY: THE MONTH OF MARY

The entire month of May has been set aside to honor Mary, Mother of God. The custom of a month dedicated specifically to Mary includes thirty daily spiritual exercises honoring Mary. Special devotions are organized on each day throughout the month. This custom became especially widespread during the nineteenth century and remains in practice until today.

The specific ways on how Mary is honored in May depend on the customs of the people. In general, there is sacred custom of daily recitation of the Rosary in parish churches, in families and in groups and even individually, and many erect a special altar with a statue or picture of Mary as a reminder of Mary's month. We are all encouraged during this month to turn toward Mary the Mother of God and our Mother too, in prayer, especially the rosary.

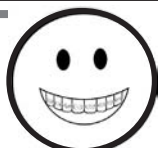
