For preparations and going through the necessary process in the parish please contact the parish office one year before the intended date. At least one of the parties should be Catholic and registered in the parish.

Baptism: Baptism is the first of all the Sacraments, and the gateway into the church. Parents, the first teachers, who solemnly promise to raise their child in the faith, should be registered members of the Parish and should attend a preparation program on effective ways to raise their child in the faith.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a program of preparation and instruction designed to initiate those who desire to become members of the Catholic Church. GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY John 10:27-30

Jesus describes his care for his sheep. The fourth Sunday of Easter is also called Good Shepherd Sunday. In John's Gospel we learn about the familiarity and intimacy between Jesus and his disciples, expressed as recognizing and knowing another's voice.

This week's Gospel also speaks to the relationship between Jesus and the Father. Jesus identifies so closely with the Father that he tells us that they are one-not just close, but actually one. To know Jesus is to know the Father. Jesus doesn't just bring us closer to the Father. Jesus puts us directly into contact with God the Father, removing all distance between us. Our relationship with Jesus is an invitation to share in the life of God. Loyola Press
