Parents, the first teachers, who solemnly promise to raise their child in the faith, should be registered members of the Parish and should attend a preparation program on effective ways to raise their child in the faith.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a program of preparation and instruction designed to initiate those who desire to become members of the Catholic Church. These tote bags contain various items useful to any cancer patient, such as a lap blanket, chemo port pillow, PICC line cover, lip balm, gel hand sanitizer, chemo hat/baseball cap, puzzle book and pencil, mints, fuzzy socks, reusable bottle, tea bags, etc.

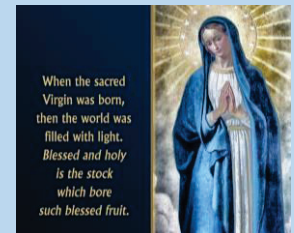

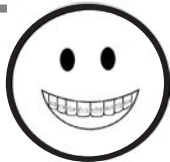
