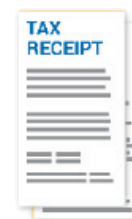

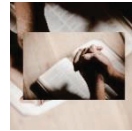
CHURCH VISITING HOURS

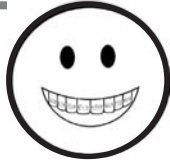
