

COLLECTION OF THE OLD BLESSED PALMS



In the Roman Catholic Church, the ashes for Ash Wednesday are obtained by burning the palms blessed on the previous Palm Sundays.

If you have old palms at home, please bring them to the Church and drop them in the box outside the parish office.

We are going to burn them and use the ashes for Ash Wednesday.



Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the liturgical season of Lent. Palms from the previous Palm Sunday are burned – ashes from these palms are distributed on Ash Wednesday as a sign of penitence.
