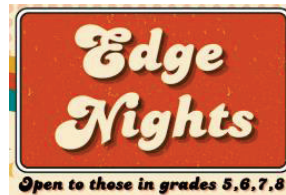
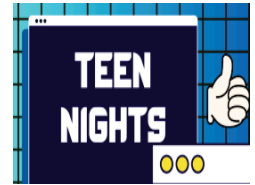
The next prayer shawl meeting is WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 13<sup>TH</sup>, in the parish hall, from 10am till noon.

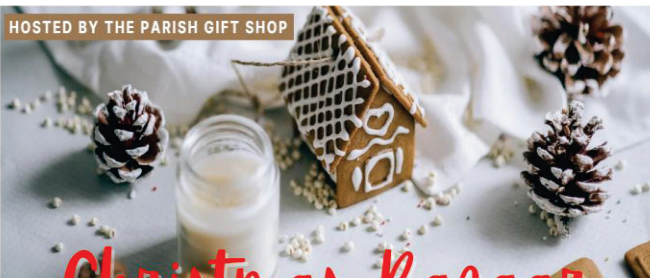
THE MISSALS HAVE ARRIVED FOR SALE FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER!
