THE LIGHT ON THE ALTAR: The Sanctuary Lamp is a special Lamp which is kept close to the Tabernacle. It remains alight to indicate and honour the presence of Christ. The living flame of the sanctuary lamp signifies the Eucharistic presence of our Lord Jesus Christ.

You may offer the Sanctuary Lamp and Our Lady of Fatima for a week long period of time, either for the intentions of or for the repose of a soul. Stipend is \$10 per week and the intention will be included on the bulletin board.

What is Advent?

A season of hope, preparation, EXPECTATION & celebration



Advent is made up of four weeks, divided into two periods:
 1 First Sunday of Advent until December 16
 focus: Christ's second coming at the end of time
 2 December 17 to 24
 focus: Preparation for celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ

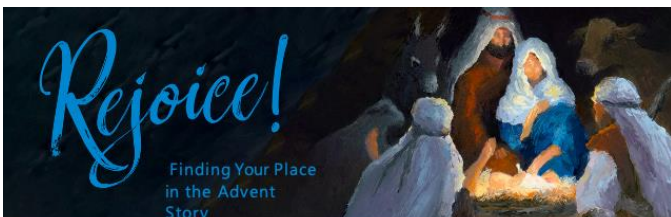
The ADVENT WREATH is a prayer symbol used as the focus of prayer throughout the season

The first Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of the liturgical year

Advent has a twofold nature: It prepares us for Christmas, when we recall Christ's first coming among us, and it is also a time when we look forward to his second coming at the end of the ages. Advent is a season of joyful expectation.

During Advent, each Sunday's Gospel reading has a specific focus. The Old Testament readings, especially those taken from Isaiah, are prophecies about the Messiah and messianic times. The selections from the writings of the Apostles present exhortations and instructions on different themes of this season.

Advent is a special season for the Church — it is the time when the world prepares to celebrate anew the coming of Christ. Often, we lose sight of the point of this season because we get caught up in our preparations for Christmas and arrive at Christmas no more transformed than we were at the start of Advent. One way that our parish is seeking to prepare for Jesus' birth and experience true transformation in this powerful season is by engaging with a new program from Ascension called "Rejoice! Finding Your Place in the Advent Story."

This Advent, we will explore the places, meet the people, and experience the events that shaped the first Advent, and find our place in the story. By immersing ourselves in the environment that God's people were living in as they prepared for the Messiah, we will experience this sacred season in a new way.

We have the opportunity to walk together on a journey to Bethlehem. **Every day participants will receive a reading, prayer and a reflection question in their email inbox.** Each Monday night in Advent, participants are invited to join the community for prayer, reflection and discussion on the weekly readings. This is an opportunity for our whole community to enter into the season of Advent intentionally and receive the grace God is waiting to give us in this holy season.



The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary


SOLEMNITY: DECEMBER 8

What it is

- It is the **conception of Mary**. Through a special grace from God, she was kept free from Original Sin and lived her whole life free from sin in order to carry out her mission as the Mother of Jesus.
- It is an **ancient Church teaching**. While it was defined as dogma by Pope Pius IX in 1854, the Church has held it as point of faith for centuries before.

What it is not

- It is **not a virgin birth**. Mary was conceived like any other person.
- It is **not the conception of Jesus**. We remember the conception of Jesus on the Feast of the Annunciation, which is celebrated on March 25.



The Miraculous Medal also known as the Medal of the Immaculate Conception has this prayer inscribed: "O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to Thee."

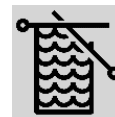

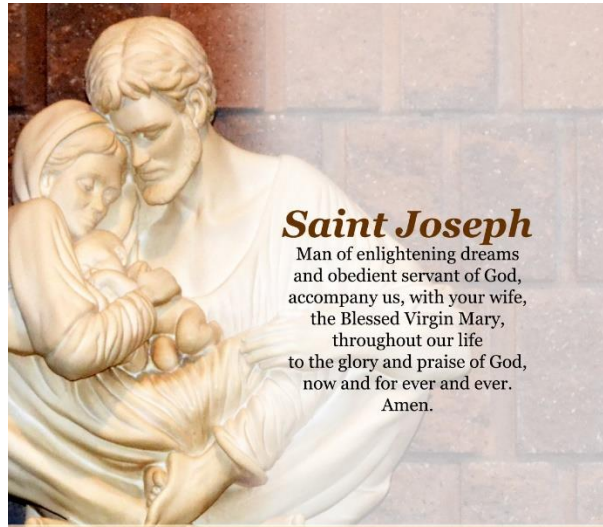

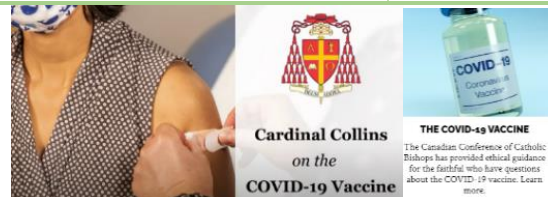
