- You have a compromised immune system.



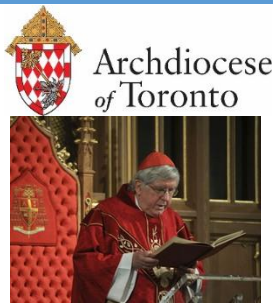
