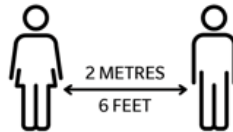

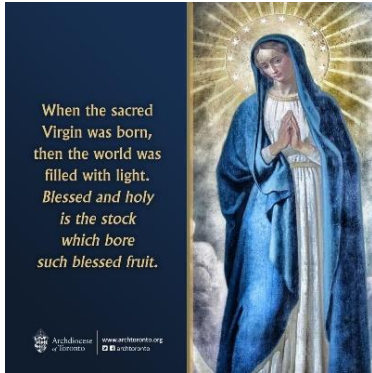

HUMANITARIAN RELIEF - NATURAL DISASTERS IN HAITI

The Archdiocese of Toronto has opened a humanitarian relief fund to assist Haiti, which in recent days has been stricken by a 7.2 magnitude earthquake and a tropical storm.

At least 1,900 people are dead, 9,000 are injured and 30,000 are homeless after a strong earthquake devastated the country on Saturday, August 14, 2021. Many people with habitable houses were sleeping outside due to fear of aftershocks causing more damage. Then on Monday evening, Tropical Storm Grace dumped more than 30 cm of rainfall onto Haiti’s coastal areas, resulting in floods and mudslides.

Haiti it is the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere and is unable to adequately respond to these natural disasters without international assistance. The country was already responding to the COVID-19 pandemic, worsening gang violence and a presidential assassination on July 7, 2021.

The Archdiocese of Toronto will send donations through Caritas Internationalis, an international confederation of Catholic humanitarian organizations with a long history of disaster relief. Caritas is already on the ground assisting Haitians, as it has been when other disasters have struck that country.

Donations to Caritas will be used for food, water, shelter, clothing and medical supplies.

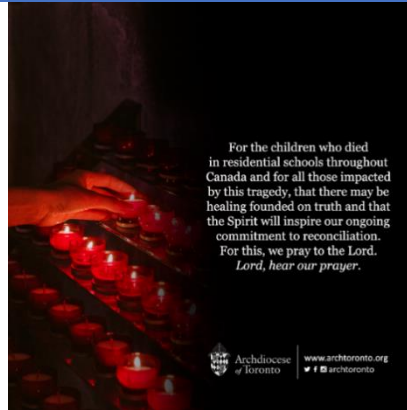

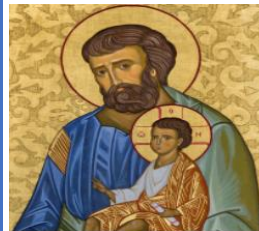


Support your Parish

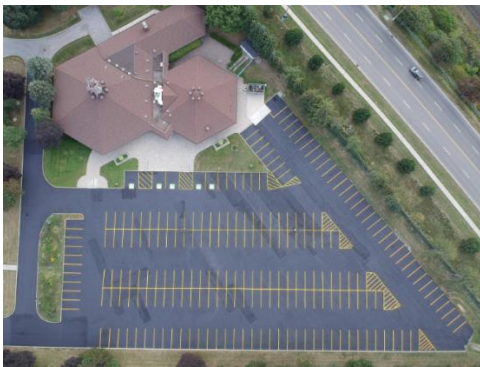

OUR PARKING LOT RENOVATION IS NOW COMPLETE!

*Just wanted to update everyone that all the work is completed and everything looks great!
We thank you all for your patience during this time.*

While the weather did push the project back a few times, we also encountered additional expenses to fix some of the sinking areas in the lot. The parking lot renovation was a maintenance project that came about as a result of an inspection done by our insurance company. Certain areas in the parking lot needed more than just a cover up, thus you will see many sections where patchwork was done. The area was first cleaned up and excavated and then asphalt was laid over. For smaller excessive areas crack filling was used instead to help us stay within budget. During the project the workers discovered that the ground was saturated in the two areas and it require paving. The decision was made to fix this issue, this required the area to be dug down 2ft, fill & compress with new aggregate before the paving was done. After the patchwork and seal coating was complete, a sealcoat was done (in some areas twice, but the company did not charge us twice). While this project did cost us quite a bit we are glad that we were able to complete the job before the areas worsened and that the job was completed within the summer time. It made more sense to do a complete job rather than a temporary fix, again we thank you all for your support
